Transportation to and from the top of Pt. Sur Lightstation - every 15 minutes  
"Lighthouse Keepers and their wives" talking about their lives at Pt. Sur  
A visit to the Lighthouse and a chance to climb the tower  
Pre-electric-era crafts and games for kids and adults. A scavenger hunt.  
Story-telling: shipwrecks and children's stories  
Flag raising, lowering, and folding for the kids, led by a Lighthouse Keeper  
Visits to the barn, blacksmith shop and Head Keeper's Quarters  
Picnicking will be allowed (bring your own food)
