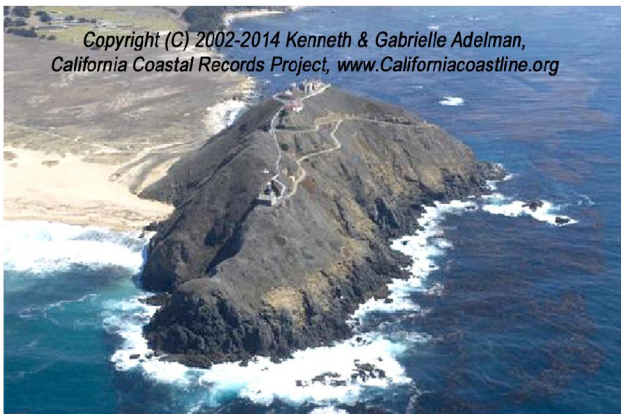


# WHALE WATCHING at LIGHTSTATION POINT SUR

*Walking Tour!!*

January 15, 2018  
Begins at 10 AM**

on the Central Coast for watching whales.  
The 360 feet high rock is perfect for  
viewing a wide area of ocean.*



Enjoy whale watching at Point Sur State Historic park in Big Sur. After an abbreviated tour to the Lighthouse, visitors will have plenty of time at the top of the rock to watch the migrating whales, picnic and relax in one of the most beautiful places in California.

Timed to make the most of the annual Gray Whale migration, this special interpretive tour will be led by trained docents with a special interest in whales.

**When:** Monday, January 15, 2018. Enter between 10 & 10:30AM for 3 to 4 hours.

**Cost:** \$20 per person. Proceeds fund the restoration of Point Sur's historic structures.

**What:** After a walking tour to the top of the rock, you will have time to picnic (bring your own food) and watch for whales. The use of several binoculars are provided.

Experts will be on hand to answer your questions. This will be very informal.
